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# Biltmore Candlelight Christmas Plus Pigeon Forge, TN

4 Days November 30 to December 3, 2020



**Day 1** - Travel today to Asheville, NC. On arrival, check into your Hampton Inn hotel for an overnight stay. This evening, you enjoy the Candlelight Christmas Buffet Dinner at Deerpark Restaurant. Then you take a Tour of the Biltmore House. Firelight and candlelight fill Biltmore House with a warm glow and accent delicate ornaments and priceless treasures.

Get into the holiday spirit with choirs singing European carols, vintage ballroom dancers, and dramatic Christmas readings. The Front Lawn of Biltmore House sets the scene with a sparkling holiday illumination of evergreens bathed in thousands of twinkling lights. This larger-than-life celebration presents Christmas with more than 40 decorated trees and is an evening to remember.



**Day 2** - Enjoy the hotel's breakfast before an audio tour of the Biltmore House. The Biltmore's Christmas decorations seen by daylight give you a whole different view. The Barn in Antler Hill Village – once the social and work center for these families – is alive again with blacksmiths, woodworkers, and other craft demonstrations; an old-fashioned Mercantile shop offering Appalachian crafts, dry goods, and candy. And, at the Biltmore Winery you delight in free wine tastings and a redesigned self-guided tour to learn how the award-winning wines are made.

This afternoon you travel to Pigeon Forge, TN. Check into The Black Fox Lodge for a two night stay. Located along the Little Pigeon River, the hotel offers an outdoor pool and fire pit and great mountain views. Dinner this evening will be at the delicious Applewood Farmhouse Restaurant or Grill. At Applewood Farmhouse or Grill all meals are served with their signature Applewood Julep, Apple Fritters and Homemade Apple Butter.

Then you see a Christmas show at the Smoky Mountain Opry Theater. This multi-million dollar Christmas production features flying sugar plum fairies, soaring angels, dancing elves, enchanted reindeer, Jolly ol' Saint Nick, and most importantly, the celebration of the birth of Christ with the area's largest living nativity! The incredible cast includes talented singers, dancers, comedians, live animals, and a huge band. Beautiful costumes, incredible special effects and lavish sets round out this first class Christmas experience!

**Day 3** – After breakfast, you tour the Titanic Museum providing a gateway to 1912, where First Class Maids and a variety of Officers and crew members bring the stories of the fabled ship and its fascinating passengers to life by retelling their stories in vivid, dramatic detail.
