June 30, 2020 - All Roads Lead to Gettysburg!

July 1, 2020 - Gettysburg Battlefield and President Ike's Farm!

World leaders and dignitaries visited often, and after his Presidency, the farm was his retirement home. Late this afternoon you'll travel on to **Lancaster** to check into the historic **Cork Factory Hotel** in time for dinner on your own, as your hotel is ideally situated in downtown Lancaster.
